We have heard the story of Cain and Able many times, if you are a Christian. The story centers around Cain murdering his brother because God accepted his sacrifice but not Cain's. When we look at the story, that's what most of us remember, but there is so much more to learn from the story. Here are a few lessons that might help us in our walk with God.

In chapter 4 and v. 1-2 we see that we are all the same. There is a common denominator, we all came from God and we all fall under His authority. We can look back at Genesis 1 and 2 and understand this by the creation. In v. 3-5 we see that there is a wrong and a right way. From reading the Bible we can gather that both Cain and Able knew what was expected of them, yet only one did that. God was pleased with Able but God did not respect Cain's offering. Hence, in God's eyes, we can't do whatever we please. There is right and wrong. In the 2nd part of v. 5 through verse 8 we see that there are bad reactions to disappointment, Cain is the prime example of this. In these same verses we can understand that WE control our own actions. Cain would not get over his disappointment and made a terrible decision. In v. 8-16 we see that our actions have consequences, a fact that we sometimes forget when making quick decisions or emotional ones that can lead to a lifetime of heartache. There is a right way and a wrong way and there are consequences that come from either one. Our prayer today is that each one of us choose the path that leads to eternal life. We look forward to seeing you Sunday!
