Two burglars were convicted when the satellite navigation system in their van recorded them at the scene of each of their crimes. It led to Ian Bansie, 33, and Steve Warrington, 31, who broke into ten houses in the space of three months, being jailed for a total of seven years.

Bansie used his work van to drop off Warrington outside each home they burgled, a court was told. A check of the van's sat nav gave a precise record of their movements. The men, both from Kilburn, North London, pleaded guilty to conspiracy to burglary (*oddee.com*).

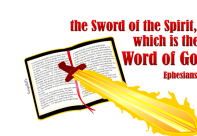
