

Below is an article I wrote for the Hartselle Enguirer this week.

Once an elementary school principle addressed her students: "Children, three things are very important," she began. "First, we want you to be happy. Only you can make yourself happy." Second, we want you to be safe. We never hurt anyone. We try hard to never hurt anyone's feelings. We never hurt another person's body. Never throw rocks. If you throw a rock, you go home immediately. Because we never throw rocks, we never even pick them up. Understand? We never even pick up rocks." Third, we want you to learn. This is a place to learn. Every day, when you go home, you should have learned something that you did not know when you came in the morning."

What a great lesson to learn! Imagine yourself living by those three rules each day. Today, decide to be happy. It is up to you. Today, don't throw rocks at anybody. Don't even pick them up.
