I heard the story about years ago when times were harder and money a little scarcer. A young man decided to get his wife some perfume. He walked into a nice store and told the lady he wanted some real good cheap perfume. Doesn't that sound just like a man? She looked at him and said, "There is no such thing sir." Well, the young husband ended up buying her a nice iron!

Isn't this what a lot of people are looking for today in religion? Some real good cheap religion. Folks, there is no such thing! Today, many want to attend a few church services when it is convenient; say a few prayers when they are in trouble; and sing a few songs when they feel good.
