Dene Walls has a PET scan next month.

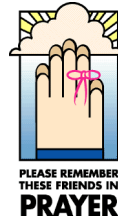
Billy Engle remains in Summerford's Rehab, Rm. 233.

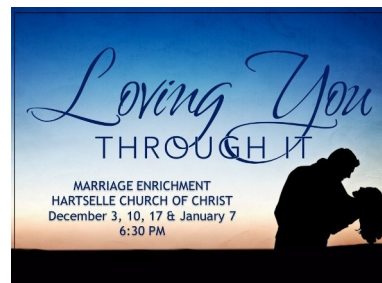
