There is a football program that runs what they call a "4th Quarter Program". The aim of the program is to get the athletes ready for the upcoming season when they are not playing. They need to be ready for the 4th quarter when the season kicks off. Christians should develop a "Spiritual 4th Quarter Program" to make sure we are always ready for the 4th quarter of life! Over the next several weeks we will look at different aspects of what a spiritual 4th quarter program looks like, adapting the tenets from the football program.
