




100 YEAR OPEN HOUSE FEBRUARY 9TH!

There is a very thin line between being humble and being haughty. It takes a lot of humbleness to finally turn our life over and surrender to Jesus. On the other hand it takes very little haughtiness to get the big head and think we don't need Jesus any longer. The Bible says that humility along with a fear of the Lord brings riches and honor and life (Proverbs 22:4). On the other spectrum it teaches us that a man's pride will bring him low (Proverbs 29:23). It's clear through biblical teaching which end of the spectrum we should be on. This Sunday we will look at some ways to recognize where our spiritual "house" is on the humble or haughty scale.
