



One of the most often used Bible verses on the subject is Philippians 4:13: I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me. I think we misuse that verse often times. I believe it's talking about spiritual strength or courage. For the Christian to be able to have courage in their life it will have to flow from the spiritual side. We must first seek the courage to stand up, fight and be unafraid spiritually before physical courage comes. In the Bible it tells us to be strong and courageous because the Lord is always with us (Deuteronomy 31:6). 2 Timothy 1:7 tells us God gave us not a spirit of fear! We also learn in Proverbs 28:1 that the righteous are bold as a lion. For us to have courage means we first trust in God for ALL of our needs: After that we can accomplish great spiritual and physical things because we are led by Him. How courageous are you?
