What are marks of a disciple?

-Abides in Jesus' words John 8:31; Matthew 7:21-27 -Loves the brethren John 13:34-35: 15:12 -Bears much fruit John 15:8; Matthew 5:16

How does one become a disciple?

-It begins with baptism Mt 28:19; Acts 2:38; 8:35-38 -It continues with learning, obeying Mt 28:20; Acts 2:42 -For we must be doers, not hearers only James 1:21-27
