A newly graduated lawyer had just opened an office. A shadow appeared on the other side of the frosted glass in the door. He thought, "My first client. I must make the right impression." As the door slowly opened, he picked up the phone and said, "No, I'm sorry, but I just couldn't take your case for any amount of money. I only have a limited amount of time available in the next six months." He replaced the receiver and looked at the visitor. "And what can I do for you?" he inquired. "Nothing really," was the reply. "I just came in to connect your telephone." Trying to impress others never works.

Recently, I was making conversation with a friend whom I had not seen for some time. We talked for at least thirty minutes. After we had departed and I was driving home, I thought about our conversation. It was then that I realized I had spent most of the time talking about me. Think for a moment about being with people who show an interest in you and encourage you to talk about yourself. They are letting you impress them. Chances are, you spend ninety percent of the time talking about yourself, and go away thinking what a great conversationalist they were! Friends, why don't we work a little harder on letting others impress us by listening to them for a change!

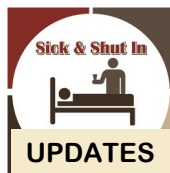
