



When things are going bad, and they do go bad for all of us at times, you cannot always change them instantly. We want things to happen instantly. We have instant tea, coffee, fast food, express lines, etc. and we want instant life changes. The first step is to recognize and admit that this cannot always be done. In other words, attitude will not change the undesirable happenings, but one can change their attitude toward them. They will change. Give wind and tide a change to change. In the meantime, we do not have to be stewing. We can decide to make the waiting time constructive and creative. Don't you know that it would have been difficult for Paul - the man of action - to sit for years in Roman prisons had he not decided to do something else worthwhile while he waited? Many of his great epistles came out of the prison years.
