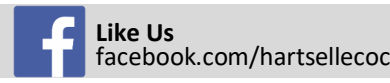

Living With The End In Mind

I read the story about a taxi driver that picked up a passenger. They were riding down the road. Without any warning, the passenger tapped the taxi driver on the shoulder. He said, "Hey buddy!" When he said that, the taxi driver screamed and lost control of the cab. He nearly hit a bus, jumped a curb and stopped inches from going through a department store glass window. For a moment nobody said anything. Then the taxi driver turned around and said, "Man, you scared the daylights out of me!" The passenger said, "I'm sorry. I didn't realize that just tapping you on the shoulder would scare you so much." The taxi driver said, "Well, it really isn't your fault." The passenger asked, "What do you mean?" The taxi driver said, "Today is my first day of driving the cab. The last twenty-five years, I have been driving a hearse and I'm just not used to anybody tapping me on the shoulder!"

The Bible says in Hebrews 9:27 *"And as it is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgment,"* It is foolish to let the last hour, or the last minute, or the last second catch you by surprise. One day death will tap you on the shoulder. For most of us, there will be no advance warning. For most of us, it will not be the doctor saying we have a certain amount of time to live. It will be unexpected. This is why we ought to begin each week, each day and each hour with the end in mind.
