

On Sunday August 2, we will begin a Sunday Zoom class at five o'clock. You will have your choice of viewing the regular Livestream at five or participate in the Zoom class at five. The Zoom class will be a class where you can interact with others. I see it more like a table discussion. Harry Fuller will be the discussion leader for the class. All you must do is sign the list in the Commons area or call the church office. Give us your email, and you will receive a link through email that will take you right to the class. You just need to connect five or ten minutes before the class begins. A computer. phone or tablet with a camera will be necessary. If you have an older computer, it may not have a camera. We have members in this church who can help you get your device setup if you need such assistance. You will be able to see and hear Harry and those in the class. I want to encourage you to try this format and see if you like it. We have a desire to start another class or two like this in the future.

# Livestreaming!

We have not said much about our Livestreaming views during this pandemic. What a blessing our Livestreaming has been to this congregation, our community and those throughout the world. We are reaching people with the Gospel like we never have before! We have four sites from which you can view our worship service and classes. Last Wednesday night when I finished my Bible Class there were right at 600 people watching my class! Our Sunday morning services are averaging around 1500 to 1700 views each week. The Sunday afternoon views are averaging somewhere between 800 to 1,000 views a week. There are some smaller congregations that do not have Livestream who are participating in our Worship service and Bible Classes. Thanks so much for your continued financial support so we can make this possible.
