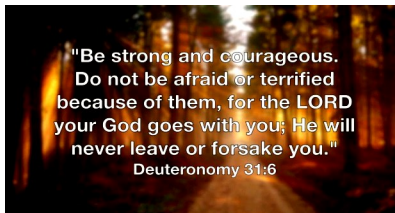

I was studying the story of **Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego** this week and it amazes me. You remember the story, right? Most people recognize it when we mention the words "fiery furnace". These 3 amazing guys had been thrown into a fiery furnace because they didn't follow **King Nebuchadnezzar's** decree to bow down to a golden image he had made. When the King found out, he was enraged and had the men thrown into the furnace. Miraculously they were saved and came out of the furnace without even the hint of the smell of smoke on them! This miracle was performed by God and really had nothing to do with the three boys, as far as the miracle being accomplished goes. Everything that led up to it was about the guys though, their faith was awesome and something we should aspire to have. The most amazing part for me comes in **Daniel 3:16-18** where the Bible says

"Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-Nego answered and said to the king, "O Nebuchadnezzar, we have no need to answer you in this matter."

"If that is the case, our God whom we serve is able to deliver us from the burning fiery furnace, and He will deliver us from your hand, O king."

"But if not, let it be known to you, O king, that we do not serve your gods, nor will we worship the gold image which you have set up..."

Now this was after they were told they would go into the furnace if they didn't do what they had been told. Even in the face of physical consequences it was their spiritual relationship with God that mattered the most, wow! How will our faith look when faced with physical consequences if we remain faithful to God? I hope and pray we will look at this story for more than the furnace miracle (as awesome as that was) and look at it as an example of how strong our faith should be!
