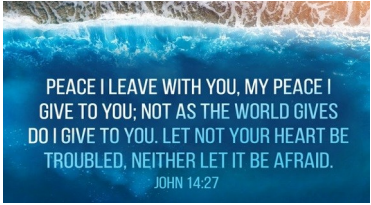

Some have been wondering about the Lads to Leaders/Leaderettes Convention for 2021. Plans are being made to have the convention this year in Atlanta April 2-4! Several changes have been made for the convention due to Covid-19. Puppets will be taped at the home congregation and sent in for judging. Winners will be awarded at the Saturday night ceremonies. The Puppet rules can be found on the L2L webpage. There will be no Friday night ceremonies this year. All awards for Friday night will be sent home with the congregations. Events such as speech and song leading will take place on Friday night to help with social distancing in the event rooms. We are working on a schedule of events. We will get the schedule to you when it is finalized.

Strict Covid-19 protocols will be followed during this time. Masks covering the mouth and nose must be worn at all times including inside event rooms and ceremonies, by presenters, judges, and audience members. Masks may be removed while in a personal guest room or while eating. Masks must remain in place while in food lines or selecting food items. Children under the age of 2 years are not required to wear a mask. Temperatures will be checked each morning by group leaders. All Covid-19 guidelines can be found on the L2L webpage.
