
## Congratulations to another UNIVERSITY GRAD

# **Barrier's Blog**

Recently we were discussing Matthew chapter 7 in our Bible class. More specifically we were learning about verses 3-5. The Bible says this...

"And why do you look at the speck in your brother's eye, but do not consider the plank in your own eye? "Or how can you say to your brother. 'Let me remove the speck from your eye'; and look, a plank [is] in your own eye? Hypocrite! First remove the plank from your own eye, and then you will see clearly to remove the speck from your brother's eye." Often these verses are taken out of context or part of the verse is used and the other is ignored to shame "judgement" upon others. If we read the verse correctly that's not at all what it's saying. We are being taught that we can't help anyone else with sin in their life if we aren't willing to look at the sin (or "plank") in our own life. After all we are instructed in these verses to remove the speck from the other's eye after our plank has been removed. Basically there is a process to being able to point out things that may be helpful to the eternal soul of someone else. As it's described by Paul in Philippians 2:12, we first must *"work*" out our own salvation" or remove that plank from our own eye. We have no standing to try and judge or help or whatever we want to call it, the lives of others if we aren't willing to look at ourselves in the mirror. We are to develop Christlike character that pushes us towards recognizing and eliminating sin in our lives so that we have the kind of character others would be willing to listen to. Are you working on your own salvation or unrighteously judging others first?
