One of the trickiest things we can do as Christians is watch out for each other. Sounds pretty easy, right? However, in today's society when we look out for each other it often gets looked at as snooping or overstepping our boundaries. Even though it might be difficult or even looked at as intrusive (which it can be if not done out of love and care for the other person), we are called to do it. In Philippians 2:4 the Bible says...

Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others.

This is just one verse of many that speaks of looking out for and caring for one another. It reminds me of the story of David and Bathsheba in 2 Samuel. Can you imagine how different things may have turned out if David had someone looking out for him and told him to stop what he was doing? We know he may have listened because after the whole incident Nathan the prophet came to him. Nathan was someone David trusted. He was told by Nathan how wrong he had been and David repented. This happened because someone was willing to speak up and look out for another. David was a man after God's own heart but still needed someone else to help him get to where he needed to go!
