Oftentimes when someone becomes a Christian they are what many describe as "on fire for the Lord". Of course this means they are highly motivated to love and work for the Lord and they show it! This is great, it's wonderful to be motivated to be a part of God's family. Many times that response comes from those who have no experience with religion and are on a "spiritual high". As I often tell my Bible class students, when you become a Christian the world and Satan really begin to focus on you. This can be discouraging to those new and excited Christians that are just ready to be a servant. A lot of times the disappointments after this initial excited beginning drive some away from the faith. Some things that disappoint new Christians (and veterans as well) are falling back into old habits (disappointed in oneself), other Christians showing inconsistency and setting bad examples, lack of support from friends to grow spiritually, continued struggles in life and many others. The thing we can do to encourage people who have become discouraged is to remember that God said things won't always be easy (John 16:33) but because of Him we can overcome it. Also remember when people disappoint you that is no reason to leave the faith, why? The reason is we are all imperfect and our relationship with God shouldn't change because of what someone else has done to us. We are followers of Christ not men. So stay "on fire" for the Lord and prepare ahead of time for those disappointments, because they will come, but in the end Heaven is worth it!
