# Calling in the Dog

There is an old story about an elderly couple who lived in the mountains. They were sitting in front of the fireplace one evening passing the time. After a long silence, the wife said, "Jed, I think it is raining. Get up, go outside and see." The old mountaineer continued to gaze into the fire for a second. Then he said, "Aw, Ma, let's just call the dog in, and see if he is wet!"

In much the same way, many Christians have become lazy in their labor. One of the saddest things to observe is that we have come to the place where we have learned to live with mediocrity. No longer does anyone try to do what needs to be done, or what is expected of them. It seems today, the average Christian seeks to cut corners, take the short-cuts, and come through the back door to just get by. The reason so many of us muddle along in mediocrity is that we are too lazy to do anything about it. It is not that there is a lack of opportunity, or a lack of ability. There is a lack of desire to do something about it! Therefore, it is so easy to let someone else do the work that we ought to be doing. Or, to just call in the dog!

Just in a few words, Solomon warns us about laziness. He writes in Ecclesiastes 10:18, Because of laziness the building decays, And through idleness of hands the house leaks.
