





# **Barrier's Blog**

Community is a huge part of being a Christian. Over the last 20 months online church has become huge. The need was there. the technology was there so it was a smart and useful tool. Online church services aren't going anywhere, and they shouldn't. We need that alternative in the world we live in today. However we need to make sure it doesn't become a crutch.
