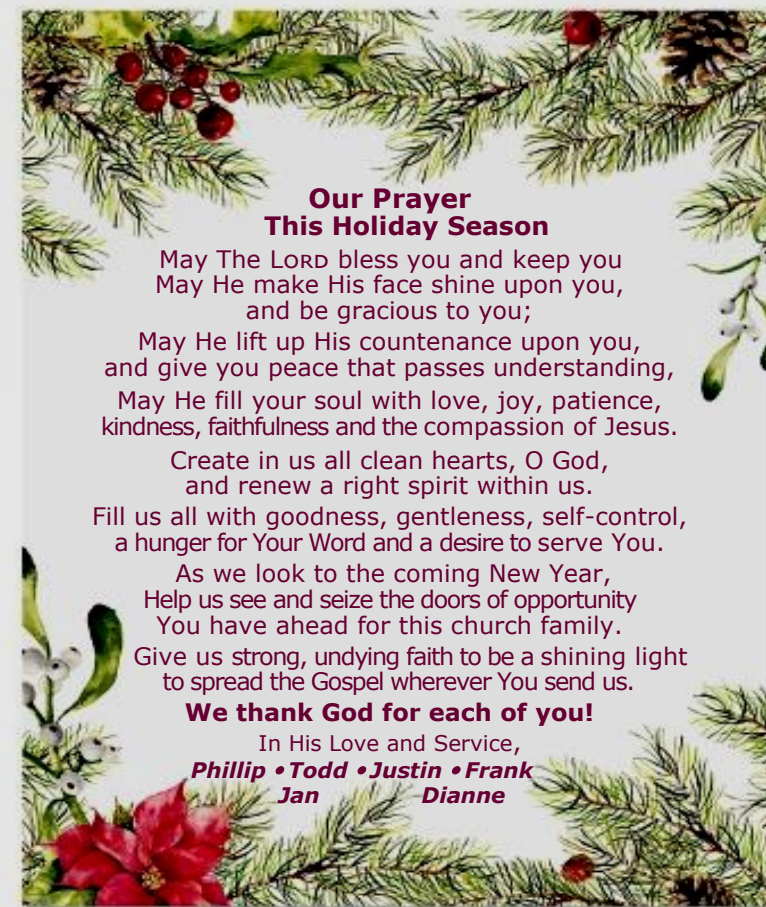

-Try not to worry so much, do what you can and go to God with your concerns...*[Matthew 6:33-34 NKJV] "But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you. "Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about its own things. Sufficient for the day [is] its own trouble.*

-Slow down and enjoy your time and your family, time is one thing we can't get back...*[Ecclesiastes 3:1 NKJV] To everything [there is] a season, A time for every purpose under heaven: [James 4:13-14 NKJV] Come now, you who say, "Today or tomorrow we will go to such and such a city, spend a year there, buy and sell, and make a profit"; whereas you do not know what [will happen] tomorrow. For what [is] your life? It is even a vapor that appears for a little time and then vanishes away.*

-Give more, not just presents, but time, effort, listening, caring, love, etc...*[Act 20:35 NKJV] "I have shown you in every way, by laboring like this, that you must support the weak. And remember the words of the Lord Jesus, that He said, 'It is more blessed to give than to receive.'*
