

Last week we began a look at some of the fundamentals of Christianity. We are doing this to help our faith grow as we face challenges in the coming year. A strong foundation is helpful in withstanding life's storms. We began by looking at the basic building block, belief in the deity of Christ. We build on that this week by looking at our next fundamental, belief in the inspiration of the Bible. To be able to base your whole worldview on the Bible you have to believe it came from God, not just godly people, but that it was God breathed!

Many people believe the Bible is a great read, but to live your life by it you must go deeper than that! The words of the Bible teach us to trust that it is from God. In 2 Timothy 3:16-17 we are told that ALL scripture is given by inspiration of God. In 2 Peter 1:20-21 we are told that no scripture is of any private interpretation but that these words were written as the writers were moved by the Holy Spirit. So the book that we say we believe tells us that it's words came from God. So belief that the Bible is inspired is a basic fundamental of Christianity. Next week we look at "Recognition of the Authority of Scripture" as a basic building block. Do you believe that the Bible is inspired?
