

We have been looking at fundamentals of Christianity over the last few weeks. So far we have touched on the belief in the deity of Christ, the belief in the inspiration of the Bible, recognition of the authority of scripture and membership in His church. We are told to sing praises (spiritual hymns and songs), to pray (fervently), to give an offering (cheerfully) among other things. The way we find out how to do these things in a proper manner is written out for us in the Bible. Study of His Word will help us worship in spirit and in truth, just as He has commanded us. For our foundation to be strong we must worship scripturally. Are you worshiping in spirit and in truth?
