In our lives we are constantly around others. We live next to others, we walk next to others, we eat next to others...you get the idea. A famous insurance agency has a song that says they are like a good neighbor, they are always there. The Bible tells us to love our neighbors. I believe it means all the people we are around, not just those who are next door to us. So how are we able to be a good neighbor? If we are always around others, it means we are to be practicing being a good neighbor, quite literally, the majority of our time. In this column, over the next few weeks, we will examine how to be a good neighbor. This week, let's answer that question above with biblical evidence. I said I believe a neighbor is anyone, so am I right? Who is my neighbor? In Luke 10:29 that exact question is asked. When Jesus told an inquiring lawyer to love your neighbor as yourself, he asked exactly that question. Jesus followed with the story of the Good Samaritan. In Luke 10:30-37 Jesus tells the story we have heard before. How a man was beaten and robbed and left for dead. A priest and a Levite walked by without helping, but one of the Jews enemies, a Samaritan, helped. He went above and beyond. Then Jesus asked the lawyer, who do you think was his neighbor? Of course, the lawyer answered the one who helped him. This showed them, and us, that anyone could be our neighbor, even an enemy. A good neighbor doesn't ignore someone in need. So who is my neighbor? Anyone can be our neighbor! We will continue to study how we can be a good neighbor over the next few weeks. Are you a good neighbor?
