In Matthew 7:1 the Bible says "do not judge". In today's society this verse is brought up quite often when Christians speak up against certain things. I believe this verse is used in an incorrect way by both Christians and non believers alike. To prove this we simply have to keep reading. The verses following this go on to say things like "Hypocrite! First remove the plank from your own eye, and then you will see clearly to remove the speck from your brother's eye" Jesus is teaching that to judge righteously we must take care of sins in our own life before we can help anyone else with theirs. In other places in the Bible we are told to judge by others fruits, teachings, etc...The key to this is not to be hypocritical, not to just accept all behavior that we see in others (and in ourselves!)
