





In the news this week are some striking images from the new James Webb Space Telescope (JWST). Like the Hubble that went up in 1990, the JWST is giving us new images of our universe that are truly jaw dropping. In one image, there are thousands of glowing objects which might be mistaken for a sky full of funny shaped stars; however, each glowing dot is an individual galaxy. It's estimated that our own galaxy, The Milky Way, has AT LEAST 100 billion planets, but likely it has billions more. 

I believe this verse is used in an incorrect way by both Christians and non believers alike. To prove this we simply have to keep reading. The verses following this go on to say things like "Hypocrite! First remove the plank from your own eve, and then you will see clearly to remove the speck from your brother's eye" Jesus is teaching that to judge righteously we must take care of sins in our own life before we can help anyone else with theirs. In other places in the Bible we are told to judge by others fruits, teachings, etc...The key to this is not to be hypocritical, not to just accept all behavior that we see in others (and in ourselves!) We will be judged by the same judgement we give (Matthew 7:2). The plank in our eye shouldn't blind us to our shortcomings while pointing out others.
