I enjoyed seeing many proud parents post about their children and telling the world about how much they love their son or how proud they are of their daughter. Since becoming a parent I've learned this is just what parents do. In fact, as I was getting my haircut this morning, I could not help but pull out my phone and show my barber pictures of Wyatt. Parents have so much love for their children, and it delights them to talk about them with others.

Have you ever thought about our heavenly Father in this way? Repeatedly in scripture, followers of God are referred to as God's children or His sons and daughters.
