Service To One Another

This week I was rereading the book "Letters To The Church" by Francis Chan. This paragraph stuck out to me. While writing on the topic of Christian servitude and Philippians 2:1-8 he says,

"God wants you to resemble His Son, especially when you gather with your church family. Do you show up to gatherings looking to serve? As some of you read that question, you feel burdened – like a weight was just placed on you. You already live a busy life, and you want the church gathering to be a place of rest, where you can be fed. If you think that sitting back and letting the church staff feed you will bring the most fulfillment, you are so wrong. God promised that those who give will be most blessed (Acts 20:35). Takers are the most miserable people on earth. It is our inability to take our eyes off ourselves and put them onto others that destroy us. This is what Jesus saves us from. This is what the Holy Spirit wants to do in us. The most humble people are typically the happiest.

In the same chapter, Chan also says,

"At the core of our faith lies this belief that almighty God humbled Himself to serve us and die for us. At the root of our calling is a command to imitate Him by serving one another."

To be a Christian is to be a servant, and we serve in many ways. Some of our service is behind the scenes; like our card writing ministry, food delivery, or AV team. Some of our service is in front of the congregation; like those who use their gifts to lead in worship or teach Bible class. While our service might be different from one another, the most important thing is that we all answer the Savior's call to serve.
