



Sons and Daughters

This week you probably saw lots of posts online about National Daughters Day, and tomorrow you'll see similar posts as it will be National Sons Day. I enjoy seeing many proud parents post about their children and telling the world about how much they love their son or how proud they are of their daughter. Since becoming a parent I've learned this is just what parents do. Oftentimes I can't help but to get my phone out and show off different pictures of my son doing silly things.

Parents have so much love for their children, and it delights them to talk about them with others. Have you ever thought about our heavenly Father in this way? Repeatedly in scripture, followers of God are referred to as God's children or His sons and daughters. Just like any loving parent, God enjoys celebrating His children too. In Job 1 we see God bragging about his child Job to Satan. In verse 8 He says, "Have you considered my servant Job, that there is none like him on the earth, a blameless and upright man, who fears God and turns away from evil?" 
