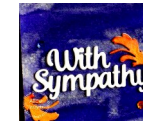
### BLESSING BAGS

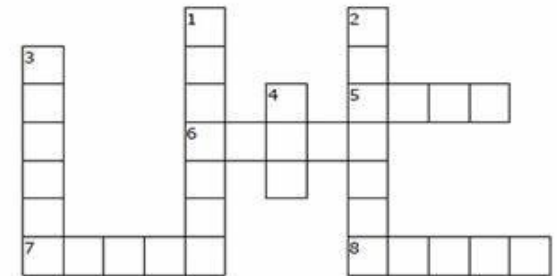


### OFFICE CLOSED
