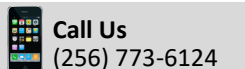
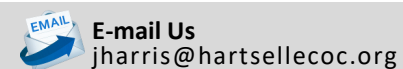
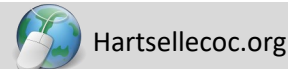
Workday

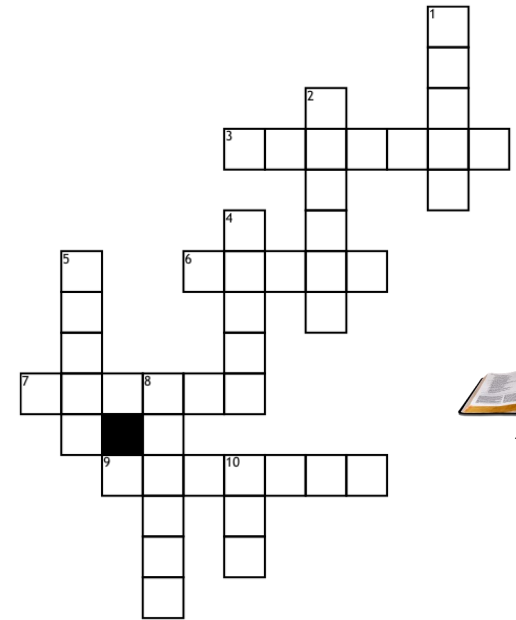
