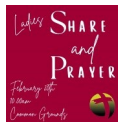
BRIDALTEA

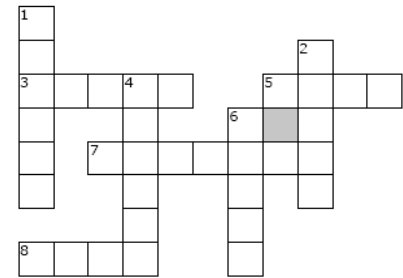
