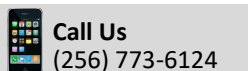
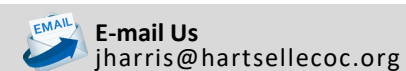

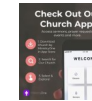
### "YOU'VE GOT MAIL"
