Renovation Update

The old auditorium renovation is cruising along! I am shocked by how quickly it has gone. There is still a lot to do, but the work that has been done is incredible. One of the most impressive things to me is how few projects we have had to hire out. Demolition, framing, painting, electrical, and more have all been done "in-house" so far. This is made possible by the many men and women who have dedicated their time and skills to this renovation. Our congregation is extremely blessed with individuals who love this church and are willing to serve by going above (literally) and beyond the normal call. I would guess there have been about 40 men and women who have helped in one way or another, with a small group of that number working 15+ hours per week since the beginning of June. If you've helped in any way so far, please know that you are greatly appreciated.

We are on track to be fully open by the time our Summer Series and Round Table Discussions finish up at the end of August. The finished product is going to look great and will generate some excitement, I'm sure. It will both feel new as well as remind you of the past. As with anything we do though, our ultimate purpose with the space is the glory of God. While we will have new opportunities because of the renovation, we will of course continue to conduct Bible classes and have the occasional worship service in the renovated space. 52 years ago (August 27th, 1972) was when this auditorium was first officially opened. Since then, countless worship services, weddings, funerals, and baptisms have taken place in this area. The ongoing renovation is at least the 3rd renovation of this space. There is a legacy of service and love to the Lord in this specific geographic location.

Though I am confident it will outlast me, the reality is this building will not last forever. At some point we may outgrow it, we may shrink and be too small for it, or in the distant future it may become beyond repair. Praise the Lord that the church is not the building! Christ's church is eternal. It needs no renovation. The one-time purchase with His blood established a movement, a kingdom that cannot be shaken. For over 2,000 years the Kingdom of Christ has been in power with no signs of weakness or dilapidation. In this Kingdom there is eternal worship (Rev 4:8), a one-time marriage (Rev 19:7-9), and best of all, no funerals (Rev 21:4). I'm thankful and proud to be connected to the Hartselle congregation, and the impact it has had on this community for the last 100+ years. I take greater satisfaction knowing this congregation is connected to the universal Church that has been working for ages in the past and ages in the future.
