Super Sunday

Every few months, we set aside a Sunday to share in something special: worship together, a fellowship meal, and a brief devotional to close the day. We call it "Super Sunday." But what truly makes a Super Sunday *super*?

It's not the food, though we certainly enjoy it. It's not the schedule, or even the tradition itself. What makes a Super Sunday special comes down to two simple, yet powerful realities: the **Lord** and **you**.

First, the Lord is at the center. "Unless the Lord builds the house, those who build it labor in vain" (Psalm 127:1). Our time together spiritual, not just social. We gather as His people, redeemed by His grace, united in Christ. When we pray together, encourage one another, and reflect on His goodness, the Lord is actively shaping our fellowship into something meaningful and lasting.

Second, you make it special. Fellowship is created through participation. Your presence matters. Your conversations matter. Your willingness to sit with someone new, to listen, to laugh, to share a meal, these are the moments where bonds are formed and strengthened. Hebrews 10:24-25 reminds us to "consider how to stir up one another to love and good works... encouraging one another." Super Sunday is one of the simplest, most tangible ways we live that out.

So what makes a Super Sunday super? The Lord working among His people, and His people showing up, engaging, and loving one another well.
